

6. AND BE IT ENACTED, That in no place shall this road rise or fall more than will form an angle of five degrees with an horizontal line.

Road shall be level.

7. AND BE IT ENACTED, That where in the opinion of the company, any part of the road will not require stoning, and can at a diminished expence be placed in a situation to answer every end of stoning, they may adopt such mode, and shall be entitled to equal tolls from the same, as though it had been stoned: *Provided*, It be kept in full, ample and sufficient repair, and made to answer the end of travelling, equally with the other parts of said road.

Parts not requiring stoning.

Proviso.

8. AND BE IT ENACTED, That if the before mentioned company shall not proceed to carry on the said work within eighteen months from the passage of this act, and shall not complete the same in eight years thereafter, in the manner prescribed by the act aforesaid and this act, the right of the said company to the said road shall revert to the State, and this act shall cease to operate and have effect.

Road not being commenced or completed in limited times, the right thereto shall revert to the state.

9. AND BE IT ENACTED, That if the several banks in this State shall elect and bind themselves to pay the said sum of twenty thousand dollars, it shall be the duty of the treasurer of the western shore to demand of the said banks their respective quota of the said sum, on the first day of January in each and every year, during the continuance of this act, after the first day of January eighteen hundred and fifteen.

Treasurer may demand payment—when.

10. AND BE IT ENACTED, That if the several banks in this State shall not, on or before the first day of October next, elect and bind themselves to pay to the treasurer of the western shore the said sum of twenty thousand dollars, in the proportion aforesaid, and the said banks in the city of Baltimore and Washington county, shall not, on or before the first day of October next, subscribe for as much stock as will complete the road aforesaid, in the manner prescribed by the act of November session eighteen hundred and four, chapter fifty-one, then this act shall cease to operate and have effect.

Banks not subscribing before Oct. 1, 1813, this act to cease.

11. AND BE IT ENACTED, That should any of the said banks refuse or neglect to come into the terms hereby proposed, the charter of such banks shall not be extended by this act, the benefit and advantage of such extension to be enjoyed only by such banks as comply with the terms herein mentioned.

Banks not complying with the terms of this act.
