disbursement by the Treasury Department to the thirty-five (35) institutions listed in the program and performance statement on transmittal from the State Department of Health. Eligibility for State aid for hospital in-patient care of individuals in the named institutions shall be determined by the local Department of Public Welfare under policies established jointly by the State Department of Public Welfare and the State Department of Health. General Hospitals shall be reimbursed at the lesser of billings to other patients for like services or a rate determined as follows: 80% of per diem cost not to exceed 60% of the State-wide weighted average cost, except that hospitals having a per diem cost above \$13.00, of which 80% would be less than \$13.00 shall be reimbursed at \$13.00, and hospitals having a per diem cost of less than \$13.00 shall be reimbursed at cost. In the event that the Federal Government makes funds available to the State for hospitalization of the indigent any part of this appropriation may be used for matching purposes by mutual consent of the institutions and the State Department of Health 3,422,899

General Fund Appropriation to Special Hospitals providing funds for long term illness for disbursement by the Treasury Department to the ten (10) institutions listed in the program and performance statement on transmittal from the State Department of Health. Eligibility for State aid for hospital in-patient care of individuals in the named institutions shall be determined by the local Department of Public Welfare under policies established jointly by the State Department of Public Welfare and the State Department of Health. Payments to Special Hospitals shall be at the lesser of (a) \$5.50 per patient day, or (b) cost per patient day; except that Tuberculosis Hospitals shall be paid the lesser of (a) the average cost in State-owned tuberculosis
