mediately after said election due returns shall be made to the Governor of the vote for and against said proposed amendment, as directed by said Fourteenth Article of the Constitution and further proceedings had in accordance with said Article.

## CHAPTER 627

(House Bill 92)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 308 of Article 43 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition), title "Health", sub-title "Plumbing", making it a misdemeanor for any person to work at the business of plumbing in this State, or to offer to practice plumbing or to use in connection with his name or otherwise assume, use, or advertise any title or description tending to convey the impression that he is a Master Plumber, unless such person has been issued a certificate of competency by the State Board of Commissioners of Practical Plumbing, as provided by this sub-title of this Article.

AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 308A TO ARTICLE 43 OF THE ANNOTATED CODE OF MARYLAND (1951 EDITION), TITLE "HEALTH", SUB-TITLE "PLUMBING", SAID NEW SECTION TO FOLLOW IMMEDIATELY AFTER SECTION 308 THERE-OF, RELATING TO THE USE WHICH MAY BE MADE OF ADVERTISEMENTS BY MASTER PLUMBERS AND REGISTERED PLUMBERS, AND PROVIDING THAT THIS ACT SHALL BE APPLICABLE ONLY IN BALTIMORE CITY.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 308 of Article 43 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition), title "Health", sub-title "Plumbing", be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, THAT SECTION 308A BE AND IT IS HEREBY ADDED TO ARTICLE 43 OF THE ANNOTATED CODE OF MARYLAND (1951 EDITION), TITLE "HEALTH", SUBTITLE "PLUMBING", SAID NEW SECTION TO FOLLOW IMMEDIATELY AFTER SECTION 308 THEREOF, AND TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

308. [If any person shall work at the plumbing business in this State without being qualified as required by this sub division of this Article, he shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeaner, and, upon conviction thereof, shall be fined not less than Five Dollars, nor more than Fifty Dollars, for every day or every part of every day that such workman shall work at the plumbing business.]
