*East Fork*—Bridge on secondary road joining Highway No. 213 and No. 447.  
*Southeast Creek*—Bridge at Highway No. 213.

*Island Creek*—Bridge on Sparks Mill Road.  
*Granny Pinley Branch*—Bridge on Sparks Mill Road.
