## CHAPTER 641

## (House Bill 277)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 331 of Article 81 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition), title "Revenue and Taxes", sub-title "Retail Sales Tax Act", extending the return day for the payment of Retail Sales Tax to the last TWENTY-FIRST day of each month and removing certain obsolete wording in said section.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 331 of Article 81 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition), title "Revenue and Taxes", sub-title "Retail Sales Tax Act", be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, and to read as follows:

331. [Before the fifteenth day of August, 1947, and before] Before the [fifteenth] last TWENTY-FIRST day of each calendar month [thereafter,] every vendor who has made any sale at retail taxable under the provisions of this sub-title during the preceding calendar month shall make a return to the Comptroller. The Comptroller may permit or require such returns to be made for other periods and upon such other dates as he may by regulations specify.
