House Bill No. 821—Classes of Chauffeurs' Licenses

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 88(a) of Article 66½ of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition), title "Motor Vehicles", sub-title "Administration—Registration—Titling", and to repeal Section 88(f) of said Article and sub-title, clarifying provisions as to the requirements for operation of school buses and vehicles used as public or common carriers of persons.

Dear Mr. Speaker:

House Bill 821 was intended to eliminate the distinction between the classes of chauffeurs' licenses issued by the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles. Unfortunately, the bill also eliminates, except for school busses, the requirement that a driver of a motor vehicle used as a public or common carrier vehicle, must be at least eighteen years of age. Thus the age limit for driving large busses, taxis, and other similar vehicles would be lowered from eighteen to sixteen years. This is a definite step backward in the field of highway safety, and I am sure it was not the intention of the sponsor of this bill, which I have today vetoed.
