

## CHAPTER 208

(Senate Bill 317)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Sections 10 and 13 of Article 36 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition), title "Fees of Officers", sub-titles "Attorneys" and "Clerks of Court", respectively, relating to the fees of attorneys and the Clerk of the Court of Appeals.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Sections 10 and 13 of Article 36 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition), title "Fees of Officers", sub-titles "Attorneys" and "Clerks of Court", respectively, be and they are hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

10. Attorneys at law shall be entitled to demand and receive the following fees, to wit:

For bringing, prosecuting or defending any suit or action at law in any of the courts of this State of original jurisdiction.....	\$ 5.00
For prosecuting or defending any cause, plaint or action, including all proceedings to collect money due on mortgage, in any of the courts of equity of this State.....	\$10.00
For prosecuting or defending any cause in any of the orphans' courts in this State.....	\$10.00
<del>For prosecuting or defending any cause in the court of appeals .....</del>	<del>\$10.00</del>
For prosecuting or defending in any criminal cases in any of the courts of this State having criminal jurisdiction, when the punishment for the offense charged is death or confinement in the Penitentiary.....	\$10.00
In all other criminal cases.....	\$ 5.00

13. The Clerk of the Court of Appeals of Maryland may charge and shall be entitled to receive the fees hereinafter set forth for the performance of his duties, as follows:

(1) For filing the record in any appeal and all duties incident thereto, ~~[\$10.00;]~~ \$20.00;

(2) For filing a motion for re-argument and all duties incident thereto, \$5.00;

(3) For a certificate under seal of the admission of any attorney, \$5.00;

(4) For any copy of a certificate under seal of the admission of any attorney, \$1.00;

(5) For furnishing copies of laws ~~[and opinions]~~ per hundred words, 12½¢;
