

title "Crimes and Punishments", sub-title "Gaming", extending the provisions of said section to cover any war veterans' organization in Kent County.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Section 317 of Article 27 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition), title "Crimes and Punishments", sub-title "Gaming", be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

317. Nothing in this sub-title shall be construed to make it unlawful for any bona fide fraternal, religious, or charitable organizations or corporations, or volunteer fire company operating in communities which have no paid fire department, to conduct or operate a game of bingo for the benefit of charity in Allegany, Anne Arundel, Queen Anne's or Kent Counties, or in furtherance of the purposes of such organizations, corporations or volunteer fire department, *and in Kent County, any bona fide war veterans organization shall also be included in the provisions of this section.*

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1955.

CHAPTER 215

(Senate Bill 389)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Sub-section (g-a) of Section 40 of Article 10 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1954 Supplement), title "Attorneys at Law and Attorneys in Fact", sub-title "State's Attorney" providing for an assistant State's attorney in Harford County.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Sub-section (g-a) of Section 40 of Article 10 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1954 Supplement), title "Attorneys at Law and Attorneys in Fact", sub-title "State's Attorney", be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

(g-a). Cecil, Harford and Wicomico Counties—The State's attorney of Cecil, Harford and Wicomico Counties shall receive an annual salary of \$4,000. The State's attorney of Cecil County shall receive an appropriation of \$500, to be used for special work and the employment of extra help, said funds to be spent only with the approval of the judge of the circuit court of Cecil County. *In Harford County, the State's attorney, with the approval of the judge for the circuit court of Harford County, may appoint an assistant State's*
