- (c) Dues to Magistrates Association of Allegany County Magistrates.—The county commissioners of Allegany County shall pay the annual membership dues in the State Trial Magistrates' Association for each trial magistrate of Allegany County who becomes a member thereof, together with \mathbf{I} mileage at the of five cents (5ϕ) per mile by the nearest route to and from the home of each trial magistrate and the place where the meeting of the Association is held \mathbf{I} all reasonable and necessary expenses incurred while attending any meeting of said Association.
- SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1955.

- AN ACT to add Section 5 to Article 94 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition), title "Time-Standard", to follow immediately after Section 4 thereof, authorizing daylight saving time in Garrett County and submitting this section to a referendum.
- SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That a new section be and it is hereby added to Article 94 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition), title "Time-Standard", said new section to be known as Section 5, to follow immediately after Section 4 thereof, and to read as follows:
- 5. Notwithstanding the provisions hereinabove in this Article or elsewhere in the laws of this State, the variation from Standard Time commonly known as Daylight Saving Time shall be effective in Garrett County as in this section provided. From two o'clock A. M. on the last Sunday in April until two o'clock A. M. on the last Sunday in September of each year, the official time throughout Garrett County shall be advanced one hour; and all courts, public offices and legal and official proceedings, in so far as the same are
