

CHAPTER 366

(House Bill 407)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 277 of Article 66½ of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition), title "Motor Vehicles", sub-title "Operation of Vehicles Upon Highways", exempting certain vehicles or trailers transporting crew shells from the maximum overall length for motor vehicles in this State.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Section 277 of Article 66½ of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition), title "Motor Vehicles", sub-title "Operation of Vehicles Upon Highways", be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, and to read as follows:

277. (Length of Vehicles.) No vehicle or combination of vehicles including the load thereon shall exceed 55 feet in length inclusive of front and rear bumpers; except that any utility poles being transported by or for any public utility company shall not be subject to the limitations provided in this section as to over-all length, and further provided that piling shall not be subject to the limitations provided in this section as to the overall length, *and provided further that vehicles or trailers transporting boats or vessels commonly known as crew or rowing shells for use in interscholastic or inter-collegiate rowing contests shall not be subject to the limitations of this section as to overall length.*

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1955.

CHAPTER 367

(House Bill 413)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 12C of Article 77 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1954 Supplement), title "Public Education", sub-title "Chapter 2. Formation of Boards", relating to the composition of the Board of Education for Prince George's County.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Section 12C of Article 77 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1954 Supplement), title "Public Education", sub-title "Chapter 2. Formation of Boards", be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments to read as follows:
