by such application for refund said vehicle will travel in the remaining portion of such year.

174. (Vehicles for transportation of property and freight; fees.)

For each such motor vehicle for the transportation of property or freight, registered upon application as provided by this subtitle (except reserve or substitute vehicles) an annual fee shall be paid to the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles, as follows:

(a) Commercial vehicles with two axles and equipped with pneumatic tires other than those electrically operated shall be divided into six classes based upon the gross shipping weight of the chassis as given and certified to by the manufacturer and the fees for each class shall be as follows:

1	Less than 2500	\$45.00
2	2500 and over but less than 3500	75.00
3	3500 and over but less than 5000	105.00
4	5000 and over but less than 6000	150.00

(b) Commercial motor vehicles with three axles and equipped with pneumatic tires, other than those electrically operated shall be divided into six classes based upon the gross shipping weight of the chassis as given and certified to by the manufacturer and the fees for each class shall be as follows:

2	3500 and over but less than 5000	135.00
3	5000 and over but less than 7000	240.00

(c) Class B. Solid Tires. For each motor vehicle equipped in whole or in part with solid tires propelled by internal combustion engines and having a rated carrying capacity of
