

## CHAPTER 506

(House Bill 579)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 250 (e) of Article 93 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition and 1954 Supplement), title "Testamentary Law", sub-title "Orphans' Court", relating to the allowance for traveling expenses for the judges of the Orphans' Court of Queen Anne's County, and correcting an error therein.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Section 250 (e) of Article 93 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition and 1954 Supplement), title "Testamentary Law", sub-title "Orphans' Court", be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

250.

(e) Compensation and travel allowance in certain counties.—Each of the judges of the orphans' court for Carroll, Charles, Dorchester, Howard, Queen Anne's, Somerset, Wicomico and **[Worcester]** Worcester counties shall receive the sum of eight dollars (\$8.00) for every day's attendance upon the sessions of said court. The judges of the orphans' court for **[Queen Anne's,]** Dorchester and **[Worcester]** Worcester counties shall receive an allowance for traveling expenses of two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00) per year, to be paid quarterly by the county commissioners of the respective counties. *The Judges of the Orphans' Court for Queen Anne's County shall receive an allowance for traveling expenses of Four Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$450.00) per year.* The judges of the orphans' court for Howard County shall receive an allowance for traveling expenses of ~~one hundred and fifty dollars (\$150.00)~~ **THREE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-SIX DOLLARS (\$336.00)** per year. The judges of the orphans' court for Somerset County shall receive an allowance of four dollars and fifty cents (\$4.50) for mileage for every day's attendance upon the sessions of said court.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1955.
