The said treasurer shall immediately after the making of the levy, in each year after the passage of this Act, publish for two successive weeks in ~~two~~ *not more than three* newspapers a short notice informing the public generally, that if taxes are paid on or before the first day of September next succeeding the date of such notice there will be allowed a deduction of three per centum from the amount of said taxes; and that on all taxes not paid on or before the 1st day of September in each year, interest at the rate of six per centum per annum will be charged. And the said treasurer shall immediately after the first day of January in each year, give a second notice, published as aforesaid, notifying the public generally that all taxes which are not paid on or before the first day of February next succeeding the date of such notice, will be collected by advertisement and sale, as provided for by law. Each of the said newspapers so designated as aforesaid shall be allowed the sum of ten dollars per annum for publishing the two aforesaid notices.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1955.

AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 107C TO ARTICLE 1 OF THE CODE OF PUBLIC LOCAL LAWS OF MARYLAND (1930 EDITION), TITLE "ALLEGANY COUNTY," SUB-TITLE "COUNTY COMMISSIONERS", TO FOLLOW IMMEDIATELY AFTER SECTION 107B THEREOF, AS AMENDED BY CHAPTER 267 OF THE ACTS OF 1949, PROVIDING THAT THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ALLEGANY COUNTY MAY IN ITS DISCRETION PAY AN ANNUAL PENSION TO CERTAIN FORMER PUBLIC SCHOOL TEACHERS NOT ELIGIBLE TO RETIRE UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF CHAPTER 447 OF THE ACTS OF 1920.

*Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 113 of Article 77 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition), title "Public Education", sub-title "Teachers' Retirement System", be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:*
