## CHAPTER 566

## (Senate Bill 185)

AN ACT to add Sub-section (t) to Section 322 of Article 81 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition), title "Revenue and Taxes", sub-title "Retail Sales Tax Act", said new sub-section to follow immediately after Sub-section (s) thereof, exempting from the Retail Sales Tax the sales of certain services, fabrications or processing upon tangible personal property. BY MILL OPERATORS ON CERTAIN WOOD PRODUCTS.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Sub-section (t) be and it is hereby added to Section 322 of Article 81 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition), title "Revenue and Taxes", sub-title "Retail Sales Tax Act", said new sub-section to follow immediately after Sub-section (s) thereof, and to read as follows:

322.

(t). Sales of any service, fabrication or processing upon tangible personal property, when the title to the property remains in the person who ordered the service, fabrication or processing and the

property is returned to that person thereafter.

(T). SALES OF ANY SERVICE, FABRICATION OR PROCESSING BY SAWMILL OPERATORS UPON TIMBER, LUMBER OR OTHER WOOD PRODUCTS, THE TITLE TO WHICH IS AND REMAINS IN A FARMER OR FARM OWNER; AND WHERE THE OBJECT OF SAID SALE, SERVICE OR OTHER FABRICATION IS RETURNED TO THE FARMER OR FARM OWNER THEREAFTER FOR USE ON THE FARM.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1955.

## CHAPTER 567

## (Senate Bill 192)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 206 (a) of Article 11 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition), title "Banks and Trust Companies", sub-title "Dormant Accounts", amending the laws of this State relating to dormant bank accounts in certain banks and other financial institutions.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 206 (a) of Article 11 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition), title "Banks and Trust Companies", sub-title "Dormant Accounts", be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:
