THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WELFARE SHALL NOT BE AUTHORIZED TO EXPEND FOR PUBLIC ASSISTANCE IN ANY MONTH AN AMOUNT IN EXCESS OF THAT COMPUTED BY DIVIDING THE TOTAL AVAILABLE APPROPRIATION FOR SUCH PURPOSE BY THE NUMBER OF REMAINING MONTHS IN THE FISCAL YEAR, UNLESS THE APPROVAL OF THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS IS SECURED FOR ANY SUCH EXCESS EXPENDITURE. THE PROVISIONS OF THIS PARAGRAPH SHALL APPLY IN THE FOLLOWING PROGRAMS:
