The Comptroller shall immediately, upon the sale of and payment for said certificates, first, return to and credit the Treasury for a sum equivalent to the amount expended as provided for in Section 4 of this Act; the remainder of the proceeds of said loan shall be credited on the books of the State Treasury Department, to be expended as needed by the State, upon approval by the Board of Public Works for the following needs, purposes and projects, the amounts listed below being intended to include Architects' and Engineers' fees where applicable:
