"Return Envelope" and shall be sufficiently larger than the other envelope, which shall be known as the "Ballot Envelope" and which is hereinafter described, to conveniently enclose and contain the Ballot Envelope. There shall be printed or written across the left hand face of the "Return Envelope" the words "Return Envelope for the election of", the blank space being filled in with the date of the election, after which there shall be added the words "Supervisors of Elections of Baltimore City", or "Super-shall be printed in bold type the phrase "Official Absentee Ballot, State of Maryland." The third envelope shall be a covering envelope in which all the balloting material shall be sent to the absentee residents, and there shall be printed on the covering envelopes the return address of the Board from which they are sent, and in bold face type the phrase, "Official Absentee Ballot, State of Maryland". The several Boards, before sending the return envelope to the absentee resident, shall cause it to be addressed to the respective Boards of Supervisors of Elections.

(2) The ballot envelope shall be of sufficient size to contain the State Absentee Ballot. Printed on the face of the Ballot Envelope shall be the following oath:
