

CHAPTER 32

(House Bill 15)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 124 of Article 43 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition), title "Health", sub-title "Practitioners of Medicine", increasing the examination fee of applicants for licenses for the practice of medicine in this State.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Section 124 of Article 43 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition), title "Health", sub-title "Practitioners of Medicine", be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

124. A fee of ~~Twenty~~ *Thirty-Five* Dollars shall be paid to the secretary-treasurer of the board, before whom the applicant appears, before such examination is had, which payment shall entitle said applicant to a second examination, in case of failure, at the expiration of six months and within twelve months thereafter; said fee to be applied by said board toward paying the expenses of said board.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1956.

CHAPTER 33

(House Bill 21)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 112 (7) of Article 77 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1955 Supplement), title "Public Education", sub-title "Teachers' Retirement System", changing the formula for the payment of supplementary pensions to the beneficiaries ~~of certain retired public school teachers in this State,~~ OR MEMBERS OF THE TEACHERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM, and correcting an error therein.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Section 112 (7) of Article 77 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1955 Supplement), title "Public Education", sub-title "Teachers' Retirement System", be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

112.

(7). Supplementary Payments.

The Board of Trustees is hereby authorized and directed, subject to the annual appropriation of the necessary funds and in addition
