 Of the amount of \$211,216 hereby appropriated, \$183,151, or any portion thereof, is to be made available for payment for services to Baltimore City patients contingent upon the amount made available by Baltimore City for the same purpose and period on an equal matching basis, and the amount of \$28,065, or any portion thereof, is to be made available for payment for services to county patients contingent upon the amount made available by the counties of the State for the same purpose and period on an equal matching basis.

All or part of this appropriation may be transferred to the State Department of Public Welfare by approved budget amendment in the event that the Board of Public Works determines that such transfer is necessary and desirable in order for the State to be eligible to receive Federal matching funds for medical care; further, all or any portion of this appropriation may be used for such matching purposes; and in the event such a transfer of this appropriation from the State Department of Health to the State Department of Public Welfare is made, the Board of Public Works shall approve a plan for continuing the programs of medical care under the provisions of Article 43, Sections 42 and 43, of the Annotated Code of Maryland, 1951 Edition.
