Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That so much of the first section of the act passed January session, eighteen hundred and fifty four, chapter one hundred and fifty-six, entitled an act for the relief of the sureties on the bonds of William Lyles, of Thomas, former collector of the third collection district of Prince George's county, as prescribes and limits the time for the payment by said sureties of the State claims against said Lyles, be and the same is hereby repealed.
