AN ACT to change the name of George Smith, of Washington county, to William Clarke Funk.

Name

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the name of George Smith, an orphan minor of Washington county in the State of Maryland, be and the same is hereby changed to that of William Clarke Funk.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the day of its passage.

CHAPTER 14.

Passed

AN ACT amendatory of an act passed at December session, eighteen hundred and forty-four, chapter two hundred and thirty-one, entitled an act to incorporate the Baltimore and Cuba Smelting and Mining Company, by authorising said company to increase its capital stock and number of Directors.

Capital
stock in-
creased.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Baltimore and Cuba Smelting and Mining Company be and it is hereby authorised and empowered to increase its capital stock from four hundred thousand dollars, the amount limited by the third section of said act, to eight hundred thousand dollars; said enlargement of capital stock to be made pursuant to the provisions of its original charter.

May in-
crease the
number of
Directors.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the number of Directors in said company may be increased from five, the number prescribed by section five of said act, to ten.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from its passage.
