## CHAPTER 16.

AN ACT to carry into effect the thirty-fifth section of February the third article of the Constitution of the State in re- 27, 1856. gard to the eligibility of persons to the offices therein specified and mentioned.

WHEREAS, The thirty-fifth section of the third article Preamble. of the Constitution of this State, declares that no person who should after its adoption become a collector, receiver or holder of public moneys, shall be eligible as Senator or Delegate, or to any office of profit or trust under this State, until he shall have accounted for and paid into the Treasury all sums on the books thereof charged to, and due by him; and whereas, there has been no law passed by the Legislature, wherein it is provided how the constitutional inhibition may be enforced, Therefore,
