CHAPTER 116.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money to pay 8, Passed Mar. Walter W. W. Bowie, of Prince George's county, for legal services rendered the State, in the trial of the cause of the State of Maryland vs. B. J. Gardner, in the Circuit Court for Prince George's County.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the sum of one hundred dollars be and it is hereby appropriated, to pay Walter W. W. Bowie, of Prince George's county, for legal services rendered the State, in the trial of the cause of the State vs. B. J. Gardner in the Circuit Court for Prince George's county, and the Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to pay to the said Bowie, upon the warrant of the Comptroller, the said sum of money as compensation for said services.
