AN ACT to incorporate the Farmers' and Merchants Passed Mar. Bank of Cecil County. 8, 1856

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That a bank to be called and established at known by the name of Farmers' and Merchants' Elkton. Bank of Cecil county, shall be established at the town of Elkton in Cecil county, and that as soon as two thousand shares of the capital stock of said company shall have been subscribed, the subscribers thereof, shall and are hereby made a corporation and body politic under the name and style of Farmers' and Merchants' Bank of Cecil county, and by that name shall be and are hereby made capable in law, to sue and be sued, plead and be impleaded, answer and be answered, detend and be defended in any court of record, or any other place whatever, and also to make, have and use a common seal, and the same to break alter and renew at pleasure and to make, issue and negotiate promissory notes, deal in bills of exchange, single bills, specie and bullion, and generally to do and execute all such matters and things as 28
