

CHAPTER. 155.

Passed Mar. 8, 1856. AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money to Nathaniel Duke, Clerk of the Circuit Court of Calvert county, for certain fees due him by the State.

Treasurer authorised to pay SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Treasurer, upon the warrant of the Comptroller, be and he is hereby authorised and directed to pay to the order of Nathaniel Duke, Clerk of the Circuit Court of Calvert county, the sum of one hundred and thirty-two dollars and seventy-six cents, being the amount of certain fees due him by the State for the years of eighteen hundred and fifty-three, and eighteen hundred and fifty-four, and eighteen hundred and fifty-five.

In force. SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 156.

Passed Mar. 8, 1856. AN ACT entitled an act to change the line dividing Election District No. 3, from District No. 5, in Allegany county.

WHEREAS, it is represented to this General Assembly by sundry citizens of election District No. 3, in Allegany county, that their convenience will be greatly promoted by change in the line dividing said District from District No. 5; Therefore,

Commissioners appointed. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Stephen Stocks, David Mahoney and Joseph Keller, be and they are hereby appointed Commissioners to change and run out the line between said Election District in such manner as to them shall seem right and proper; commencing at some point on Savage River, thence by a straight line near Mr. Recknor's tavern, on the National road, to a point on the Pennsylvania State Line.
