SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assemb'y Repealed. of Maryland, 'I'hat all those parts of an Act of Assembly entitled, an act to establish primary schools in election districts, numbers three and four, in Caroline county, passed at a session of the General Assembly began and held in the city of Annapolis, on the first Wednesday of January, in the year eighteen hundred and fifty four, and each and every clause, section and premises thereof which authorises the election of trustees of primary schools, on the assessment and collection of a tax or taxes by trustees of primary schools, in election district numbers three and four of Caroline county aforesaid, be and the same is hereby repealed from and after the first day of January eighteen hundred and fifty seven, and that from and after the first day of January, eighteen hundred and fifty seven, the office, functions and duties of trustees of primary schools, in and for said election districts, numbers three and four, shall cease and determine, and no further or other tax or taxes shall be levied or collected in the said election districts upon the property of the inhabitants of said districts by vir-
