

strict is ordered, as aforesaid, by the said Commissioners, they shall thereupon order the said examiners, or any other three examiners, to carry into effect the said orders in the premises.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That the examiners shall report to the Commissioners in writing, their decision and action in the matters confided to them, and the expenses therein; and the Commissioners shall have full power and authority to confirm said action, and record the same, and levy for the amount of expenses to them appearing reasonable. Examiners to report.

CHAPTER 175.

AN ACT entitled an act to pay Coroner's fees quarterly. Passed Mar. 8, 1856.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Register of the city of Baltimore be and he is hereby authorised and required to pay the Coroners of said city the fees due the said Coroners quarterly; the first quarter under this act to commence on the first day of April next. Fees to be paid quarterly.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from and after the date of its passage. In force

CHAPTER 176.

AN ACT to give the consent of the State to the purchase of certain lands in the city of Baltimore by the United States, and for ceding to the United States jurisdiction in and over the same. Passed March 8, 1856.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the consent of the State of Maryland be given to the purchase of certain lands in the city of Baltimore by the United States, and for ceding to the United States jurisdiction in and over the same. Consent of State.
