## CHAPTER 199.

AN ACT to authorise the county commissioners of 8, 1856. Charles county to sell and dispose of certain warehouse property in said county.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assem- County combly of Maryland. That the county commissioners of missioners au-Charles county, be and they are hereby authorised to sell, to sell and dispose of all the right, interest and property of said county, in and to the various tobacco inspection or warehouses in said county, and all the lands, fixtures, out buildings, and appurtances thereto, and the same, and any part thereof, or wheresoever situated in said county, to convey in absolute fee simple to the bona fide purchasers thereof.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That said county commissioners shall, before they make sale of any of the given. aforesaid property give at least thirty days public notice of the times, places, and terms of every such sale, by advertisement in any newspaper published in the town of Port Tobacco, and by written or printed advertisement stuck up at the post office or storehouse nearest to the site of each particular warehouse to be sold.

SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That said commis- Proceeds of sioners be and they are hereby authorised and direct-plied. ed to apply the proceeds of every such sale, deducting the necessary expenses thereof in aid of the funds raised, and in easement of the ordinary levy made upon said county for county purposes.
