

an election, forthwith to issue to the person so elected his commission for the term of service for which he has been elected.

SEC. 4. *Be it enacted*, That this act shall go into effect from the date of its passage. In force.

CHAPTER 206.

AN ACT to authorise the commissioners of Baltimore county to levy the sum of money therein named. Passed Mar. 8, 1856.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the commissioners of Baltimore county be and they are hereby authorised and required at the time of making the next county levy for said county, to levy the sum of eight hundred dollars upon the assessable property of the second election district of said county, to be collected in the same manner and at the same time that the county taxes are now by law collected, and to apply the said amount, when collected, or so much thereof as may be necessary to the full discharge of the liabilities of Cornelius Howard Owings, of said county, upon his bond, as one of the sureties of Jesse M. Lowe, as defaulting collector of taxes for said county. Authorised to levy.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from and after the date of its passage. In force.
