Arundel county, be and he is hereby authorised to make and construct, and keep in repair at his own expense a bridge over Patapsco River, from a point on the North side of said river called Ferry Bar, to such point on the South side of said river in Anne Arundel county, as the said Richard Owens Crisp may select; which said bridge shall be of the width of not less than sixteen feet, and made of good and substantial materials, with suitable abutments, and railing on each side thereof.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That the said Richard Draw to be Owens Crisp shall cause to be built and kept in re-erected.
