

to sell, lease and dispose of the same, either absolutely or upon condition.

May confer degrees.

SEC. 6. *And be it enacted*, That the said corporation shall have the right and power of conferring the usual academical degrees.

Reservation.

SEC. 7. *And be it enacted*, That the Legislature holds the right to alter, amend or repeal at pleasure.

CHAPTER 223.

Passed March 10, 1856. AN ACT appropriating a sum of money for the use of Joseph Stewart.

Treasurer to pay.

SECTION. 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Treasurer is hereby required on the warrant of the Comptroller, to pay to Joseph Stewart, or his order, the sum of eighty four dollars and eighty five cents, being the amount due him as clerk of the circuit court for Charles county, by the State of Maryland.

In force.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from its passage.

CHAPTER 224.

Passed Mar. 10, 1856. AN ACT to authorise the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Talbot county to have certain record books in his office rebound.

Preamble.
