

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Samuel T. Hopkins, clerk of the circuit court for Talbot county, be and he is hereby authorised to remove said books to the city of Baltimore and have them rebound. Authorised to remove.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the commissioners of said county be and they are hereby authorised and required to levy upon the assessable property of said county, a sufficient sum to pay the cost and expenses incurred for the rebinding of said books. Authorised to levy.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. In force.

#### CHAPTER 225.

AN ACT entitled, an act to authorise and require the commissioners of tax of Montgomery county to levy a sum of money for the relief of Martha Henley and her children. Passed Mar. 10, 1856.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the commissioners of Montgomery county be and they are hereby authorised and required to levy on the taxable property of Montgomery county, such sum of money as may in their judgment be necessary for the support and maintenance of Martha Henley, an out-pensioner, provided the same does not exceed fifty dollars per annum. County Commissioners authorised to levy.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. In force.
