Leloup, two justices of the peace of the State of Maryland, in and for the said city, be and the same is hereby made and declared to be as good, effectual and valid, to convey the land and premises therein described, to the said James McMillan, as if the said deed or instrument of writing had been signed, sealed, acknowledged and delivered by the said Edward Utley himself; Provided however, that nothing in this act contained shall affect the rights of bona fide purchasers or creditors, without notice, who may have become so before the passage of this
