SEC. 15. And be it enacted, That if any person or Personsinjurpersons shall wilfully and knowingly break, injure or feit. destroy the railroad, or any part thereof, to be erected by the said company in pursuance of this act, or shall in any manner obstruct the free passage along the said railroad, he, she, or they shall forfeit and pay to the said company three times the actual damages so sustained, to be sued for and recovered with costs of suit, before any Justice of the Peace, or in any court having cognizance thereof, by action of debt, or on the case, in the name and for the use of the said company.

SEC. 16.
