Authorised to change name.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Hagerstown Savings Bank, be and it is hereby authorised whenever the president and directors of said bank shall deem it expedient, to change the name of said bank, to that of "Hagerstown Union Bank," Provided, that before said bank shall issue any notes under the name authorised by this act, the treasurer shall be certified of the change by a copy of such resolution on the part of said bank, under the hand of the president and corporate seal of

said bank.
