

CHAPTER 264.

Passed Mar. 10, 1966.

A FURTHER supplement to the act passed at December session, eighteen hundred and twenty-five, chapter sixty-two, entitled, "An Act to provide for the public instruction of youths in Primary Schools throughout this State," so far as relates to Dorchester county.

Empowered to establish a school district.

Boundaries.

In force.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Commissioners or Trustees in election district number seven, in Dorchester county, be and they are hereby authorised and empowered to lay off and establish a school district in the aforementioned election district, to be called the Franklin School, if they deem it advisable so to do; the lines of said school district to be as follows: Commencing at the county road at the head of Jenkins' creek, running down to the river, thence running down said river to Lecompte's Creek, thence running up said creek to Dr. Lecompte's farm, thence across to the head of the creek at Dr. Ross' windmill, thence down said creek to the little Choptank River, thence up said river to Windsor's Bridge to the county road, thence with said road to the place of beginning; all within the said lines shall be known and called Franklin School District.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall be in force from and after the final passage thereof.
