

CHAPTER 265.

AN ACT to provide for the payment of legal fees ^{Passed Mar. 10, 1856.} due to Jervis Spencer, for services rendered the State.

WHEREAS, Jervis Spencer, by the direction of the ^{Preamble.} Governor of this State, was appointed to investigate how far property held in the city of Baltimore heretofore not paying taxes legally liable to taxation, and for the purposes of collecting whatever taxes were due upon said property; *And whereas,* it is right and proper that the said Spencer should be remunerated for the services thus rendered, Therefore,

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the sum of two hundred dollars ^{Sum appropriated.} be and the same is hereby appropriated to the payment of the claim of Jervis Spencer, for services rendered by him as attorney for the State in Baltimore city, and the Comptroller is hereby directed and empowered to draw his warrant on the Treasurer for said amount.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall ^{In force.} take effect from the day of its passage.

CHAPTER 266.

AN ACT to refund to Amon Green, of Baltimore ^{Passed Mar. 10, 1856.} city, certain taxes paid in error to B. F. Zimmerman, Auditor.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Treasurer, upon the warrant ^{Treasurer to pay.} of the Comptroller, is hereby authorised and required to pay to Amon Green, of Baltimore city, the sum of two dollars and forty-six cents for certain taxes paid in error.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall ^{In force.} take effect from its passage.
