

## CHAPTER 267.

Passed Mar. 10, 1856. AN ACT to provide for the payment of fees to Robert Foid and Frederick Stone for legal services for the State.

Preamble. WHEREAS, it has been represented to this General Assembly that Robert Foid and Frederick Stone rendered important service to the State of Maryland, at the instance of the Governor, in the prosecution of Nelson Bryan and Joseph Lawrence for murder, in the Circuit Court for St. Mary's county, and whereas, it is right and proper that the said Robert Foid and Frederick Stone should be compensated for the services thus rendered; therefore,

Treasurer to pay. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Treasurer, upon the warrant of the Comptroller, be and he is hereby authorised and directed to pay to the order of Robert Foid and Frederick Stone the sum of fifty dollars each for services rendered by them respectively to the State of Maryland, in the prosecution of Nelson Bryan and Joseph Lawrence for murder, in the Circuit Court for St. Mary's county.

In force. SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from its passage.

## CHAPTER 268.

Passed Mar. 10, 1856. AN ACT for the benefit of the Academies and schools of Anne Arundel county.

Treasurer to pay. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the treasurer be and he is hereby directed to pay to the commissioners of primary schools for Arundel county, the sum of eight hundred dollars annually.

Sum appropriated. SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the commissioners of primary schools for Arundel county, shall appropriate the said sum of eight hundred dollars, or
