CHAPTER 281.

AN ACT entitled, an act to appropriate a sum of money to Joseph M. Palmer, for services rendered the State, in the case of the State, versus Eli V. Parrish, Isaac D. Rowe, George Hape, and George Otto; indicted for burglary, in the Circuit Court for Carroll county, and removed thence upon affidavit, to the Circuit Court, for Frederick county. Passed Mar. 10, 1856.

SECTION. 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Treasurer of the State, be and he is hereby authorised upon the warrant of the Comptroller, to pay to the order of Joseph M. Palmer, the sum of one hundred dollars for services rendered the State, in the case of the State, versus Eli V. Parrish, Isaac D. Rowe, George Hape and George Otto, indicted for burglary in the Circuit Court for Carroll county, and removed thence upon affidavit to the Circuit Court for Frederick county. Treasurer to pay.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from and after the date of its passage. In force.
