sales of goods, merchandise, wares and personal effects of every kind, exclusive of his real estate sales and sales of houses, shall not exceed the sum of one hundred and fifty thousand dollars.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted. That every auctioneer selling in accordance with the provisions of this act, shall make under oath to the Comptroller, quarterly statements showing the full amount of his sales of every kind, in which he shall distinguish his sales of goods, merchandise, wares and personal effects of every kind, from his sales of real estate and houses; and if any of the said auctioneers shall sell any amount exceeding the limits of the sum before named in this act, he shall be liable and subject to all the penalties now imposed by law upon auctioneers who shall sell without a license.
