### CHAPTER 331.

Passed Mar. 10, 1856. AN ACT entitled, an act to amend an act entitled, an act to incorporate the Presbyterian Church in the city of Baltimore.

Preamble.

WHEREAS, by an act of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed January the twentieth, seventeen hundred and ninety-eight, William Smith, Robert Purviance, James Calhoun and others were constituted a body politic and corporate by the name of the committee of the Presbyterian Church in the city of Baltimore, and were empowered to acquire and hold property not exceeding in value six thousand dollars.

May hold real estate.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the said corporation may acquire and hold by purchase, gift, devise or bequest, real or personal property; *Provided,* the same shall not exceed in value the sum of twenty-five thousand dollars, current money.
