

sponsible in law for all acts of said agent or officer in the premises.

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted*, That the said agent or officer shall not have in his possession at any time, for the purposes aforesaid, more than fifteen thousand dollars of the notes and coin of the Easton Bank of Maryland. Agent restricted in amount.

SEC. 5. *And be it enacted*, That the said agent or officer shall give bond with security for the faithful performance of his duties in such penalty as shall be prescribed by the President and Directors of said Bank. Bond to be given.

SEC. 6. *And be it enacted*, That that the Legislature reserves to itself the right to repeal this supplement at any time. Reservation.

SEC. 7. *And be it enacted*, That this law shall go into effect from the day of its passage. In force.

CHAPTER 345.

AN ACT for the benefit of the Register of Wills for Worcester county. Passed Mar. 10, 1856.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, Released. That the Register of Wills for Worcester county, provided he shall have renewed his official bond before the first day of January, eighteen hundred and fifty-six, be and he is hereby released from the penalties imposed by law, for not filing his said bond within the time limited by law.
