pointment of the Governor in the prosecution of Robert Swift, for the murder of Jeremiah Kilhour.

121. A supplement to an act entitled, an act authorising the Comptroller of the Treasury to pay to Oelrichs and Lurman the amount of coupons lost in the United States Mail Steamer Arctic.

122. An act to incorporate the trustees of the parsonage of the Methodist Protestant Church, situate at Uniontown, in Carroll county.

123. An act amendatory of an act entitled, an act to continue the corporate existence of the several banking institutions therein mentioned, passed at January session, eighteen hundred and fifty-three, chapter four hundred and forty-one, so far as relates to the Merchants' Bank of Baltimore.

124. An act authorising the county commissioners of Frederick county, to remove from the assessment of said county, an absconding negro man, a slave for life, now assessed to Thomas J. Griffith.

125. An act to provide for the sale of the lands reserved for the use and occupation of the Choptank Indians in Dorchester county.

126. An act granting the leave of the Legislature to the devise and bequest made by Levi Hilleary, late of Allegany county, deceased, to the Vestry of Emanuel Parish; and also to the devise and bequest made by the said testator to John Hays in trust, as declared in the will of said testator.

127. An act to authorise the commissioners appointed under the act of eighteen hundred and twenty, chapter one hundred and ninety-one, to compel the purchasers at their sales to comply with the terms of sale, or in case of refusal or neglect, to re-sell the property and enforce payment for the difference.

128. An act appropriating a sum of money, to pay for a painting illustrating the surrender by George Washington of his commission as Commander-in-Chief of the Army of the American Revolution in the Senate chamber of Maryland, December twenty-third, seventeen hundred and eighty three.

129. An act for the benefit of Zadock Townsend, of Somerset county.

130. An act amendatory of an act passed at January session, eighteen hundred and fifty-four, chapter one hundred and seventy-two, entitled, an act to regulate fisheries in the waters of the Potomac river within the jurisdiction of Maryland, and to protect the breed of fish therein.

131. An act to authorise the Treasurer to pay to Isaac Nesbit, of Washington county, certain monies improperly paid by him in the treasury, as clerk of the Washington County Court.

132. An act to provide for the appointment of a Keeper of the Records of the Court of Chancery.
