

CHAPTER 81.

AN ACT appropriating a sum of money to pay J. T. B. Dorsey, for services rendered in the case of the State, against Shillinger, in the Court of Appeals in eighteen hundred and fifty-four. Passed Mar. 6, 1856.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Comptroller of the Treasury, issue his warrant to the Treasurer, and the Treasurer pay to J. T. B. Dorsey, Esquire, the sum of one hundred dollars in full for his services to the State in the trial of the case against Shillinger, in the Court of Appeals, in the year eighteen hundred and fifty-four. Treasurer authorised to pay

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. In force.

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CHAPTER 82.

AN ACT appropriating a sum of money for the payment of the claims of James Murray, Thomas A. Mitchell, Samuel S. Riley, Chaney and Pritchard, John W. Davis, James H. League, Dixon, Balbirnie & Co., James Hopkins, Noah Porter, John T. Watkins, J. Wesley White, Jesse Hays and James H. Iglehart, against the State of Maryland. Passed Mar. 6, 1856.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the sum of seventeen hundred and sixty-nine dollars and fifty nine cents, be and the same is hereby appropriated for the payment of the following claims against the State of Maryland, viz: for the payment of the fees of James Murray, Commissioner of the Land Office for services rendered the State; for payment of Thomas A. Mitchell for work and labor and materials furnished and expenses incurred in repairs of State property; for payment of Samuel S. Riley for repairing the en- Claims against the State authorised to be paid.
