And be it enacted, That in case of loss or damage on property insured, it shall be optional with the Company, to pay the loss in money, or to rebuild or repair the building or buildings within ninety days; after giving notice of their intention to do so, within twenty days after having received proofs of loss or damage.

SEC. 4. And be it enacted, That any part of their charter conflicting with this act, be and the same is hereby repealed.
