and Directors of the Howard Fire Insurance Company of Baltimore, to make insurances to any reasonable amount, not exceeding twenty thousand dollars, against loss or damage by fire, on all kinds of property in the counties of this State, as well as within the city of Baltimore.

May change location of office.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the aforesaid Company, may at any time they deem it advisable, change the location of their office to any part of the city of Baltimore.

Optional.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That in case of loss or damage on property insured, it shall be optional with the Company, to pay the loss in money, or to rebuild or repair the building or buildings within ninety days; after giving notice of their intention to do so, within twenty days after having received proofs of loss or damage.

Repealed.

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted*, That any part of their charter conflicting with this act, be and the same is hereby repealed.

CHAPTER 90.

Passed February 25, 1868.

AN ACT to authorise the County Commissioners of Harford county, to adopt and use as evidence of the ownership of assessable property in the said county, for the purposes of taxation, the assessment lists now in the hands of the several Collectors.
