## CHAPTER 95.

AN ACT to incorporate the Maryland Club.

Passed February 24, 1858.

WHEREAS, an association of Citizens has been Preamble. formed in the city of Baltimore, under the title of the Maryland Club, having for its object the promotion of regulated social intercourse among its members, and the extension of hospitable courtesies to strangers; And whereas, said association has applied for an act of incorporation in order that thereby its continued existence may be rendered more secure, and that it may be enabled to carry out with greater efficiency the objects for which it was formed; Therefore,
