

CHAPTER 96.

AN ACT to make valid a deed from William Henry Calvert and wife, to Eleanora A. Calvert.

Passed February 23, 1858.

WHEREAS, it is represented to this General Assembly, that a certain William Henry Calvert and Mary Harriet Calvert, his wife, of the city of Pass Christian, in the State of Mississippi, did, on the seventh day of September, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty-seven, execute, acknowledge and deliver unto Eleanora A. Calvert, of Prince George's county, in the State of Maryland, their deed for certain real estate therein mentioned; And whereas, the grantee in said deed is described by clerical inadvertance, as Eleanor A. Calvert, when she should have been Eleanora A. Calvert; Therefore,

Preamble.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the said deed be, and the same is hereby made as valid to all intents and purposes as if the said grantee had been properly named and described.

Made valid.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from its passage.
