SEC. 4. *And be it enacted*, That Resolution No. 8, of December session, eighteen hundred and forty, entitled, Preamble and Resolution in relation to the six per cent. dollar and other bonds of the State be, and the same is hereby repealed.

Duty of Finance Committee and Committee on Ways and Means.

SEC. 5. *And be it enacted*, That it shall be the duty of the Finance Committee of the Senate, and the committee on Ways and Means of the House of Delegates, within ten days after the close of the present session of the Legislature, to examine, count and burn all bonds and certificates for stock of the State, in the hands of the Treasurer, purchased by him for the use of the Sinking Fund, up to the close of the preceding fiscal year, and make a report to the next session of the General Assembly.

CHAPTER 110.
