AN ACT to authorise the County Commissioners of Cecil county, to build a bridge at or near Elk Landing, over little Elk Creek.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the County Commissioners of Cecil county be, and they are hereby authorised and empowered, if in their discretion they shall deem it expedient, to build a bridge over little Elk Creek, at Elk Landing in Cecil county, above the present wharves, or at any point between Elk Landing and the Railroad bridge, where the tide ebbs and flows, and the said bridge to keep in repair and rebuild at pleasure, also to levy on the assessable property of the said county, a sum or sums of money sufficient for the construction, repair or renewal of said bridge.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall have effect from and after its passage.
